1. Why Professional Email Matters

Using a professional email address (yourname@yourbusiness.com) signals legitimacy, protects your brand, and improves deliverability. Free email domains can reduce trust, increase spam filtering, and weaken your business identity.

2. Choose an Email Provider

- Google Workspace
- Microsoft 365
- Zoho Mail
- Proton Mail (business plans)
- Hosting-provider-based email

3. Connect Email to Your Domain

- Create mailboxes for each user
- Add MX records to your domain DNS
- Verify domain ownership with your provider
- Test sending and receiving email

4. Deliverability & Security Setup

- Configure SPF, DKIM, and DMARC records
- Enable two-factor authentication (2FA)
- Set up spam filtering and alerts
- Use strong, unique passwords

5. Professional Email Best Practices

- Use consistent naming conventions
- Avoid role overload (info@, support@, sales@)
- Add a professional email signature
- Separate internal and customer-facing inboxes
- Back up email data regularly
